

# Squaw Valley Senior Ski & Toboggan Clinic



**March 28-30, 2018**

For more than 20 years Squaw Valley's award-winning National Ski Patrol has been the final preparation for patrollers seeking either Senior status in toboggan and skiing, and/or simple enhancement of those disciplines. Current OET instructors wishing to re-certify their credential are also encouraged.

This event provides an opportunity to review teaching techniques, discuss their effectiveness, and practice them in a training environment. Squaw Valley's highly-trained and experienced OET, and PSIA instructors, will guide participants through the seminar on a progressive variety of resort terrain.

## Details

**Participants:** Patrollers seeking NSP's Senior level status; all other patrollers seeking to enhance their toboggan and skiing skills; current OET instructors requiring re-certification of their credential.

**Senior Candidates:** Please bring your patrol representative signed Senior documentation confirming your participation in the Senior program. Those forms will not be available at the Seminar.

**Schedule:** Half of each day will be devoted to toboggan handling. The other half will be ski instruction with ample time for discussion and feedback.



**Seminar Objectives:** Friendly, yet instructive toboggan and skiing guidance designed to improve those two important disciplines.

**Cost:** Includes toboggan, ski instruction, lift tickets and Thursday evening dinner.
